



## Year 6 Spring Term 2026

### English

In writing, the children will develop their **non-fiction writing skills**, creating **non-chronological reports** before moving on to writing their own **Suffragette speeches**. In guided reading, we will continue *The Nowhere Emporium*, focusing on **the impressions we form of the characters** as the story develops. As SATs approach, we will work with a **range of texts** and **SATs-style questions** to build confidence and exam technique.

### Maths

This term, we will focus on converting between different units of measurement, building accuracy and confidence. We will then move on to tackling 3-mark reasoning questions that require using multiple methods, all in preparation for the upcoming SATs.

### Relationships and Health Education

In RHE, the children will explore how media shapes our views and build essential skills for staying safe online.

### Geography

In geography, we will be considering the choices we can make to live more sustainably. We will be looking at energy sources, where our food comes from and considering our global footprint.

### History

In history, we will be exploring the big question 'How did women get the vote in Britain?' with a focus on Votes for Women. We will be exploring who the suffragettes were and how they differ from suffragists.

### PE

The children will focus on **gymnastics skills** (balance, coordination, body control) and **martial arts skills** (discipline, movement patterns, basic techniques) this half term in PE.

### Science

We will be learning about 'Evolution and Inheritance' with a focus on how living things have changed over time, fossils and Charles Darwin.

### Art

This term, we will be investigating the artist Lubiana Humid and exploring how activism can be shown through modern art.
