



Years 1 & 2 Spring Term 2026

English

Alongside our phonics lessons, we will be focusing on different skills to support our writing. This term, we will be focusing on skills such as using commas, understanding main clauses and writing commands.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will be focusing on multiplication and division and building upon our skills learnt last term to help us answer problem solving and reasoning questions. After this, we will be moving on to learning about money and identifying pounds and pence.

Relationships and Health Education

In RHE, we will be focusing on belonging to a community. We will be looking at what this means and the children will be thinking about their role within the community. Key vocabulary – belonging, community, safe, teams, inclusion, roles, respect.

RE

We will be building upon our learning from last term and revisiting our learning on Islam. Our key question will be 'Who is a Muslim and how do they live?'

Geography

As geographers, we will be using geographical language to refer to human and physical features of different landscapes. We will compare the landscapes in Brixham and Wanaka in New Zealand.

History

As historians, we will be exploring our key question of 'What happened to London during the great fire of 1666?' We will be having a virtual visit from the National Archives to support our learning.

PE

In PE, we will be focusing our skills within net and wall games like tennis. Then, we will be learning new skills in athletics.

Science

As scientists, we will be learning about animals including humans. We will be focusing on their lifecycles and how they grow and develop.

Art

As artists this term, we will be developing our understanding of different textures and looking at primary and secondary colours. Our focus artist is Eric Carle the author of the Very Hungry Caterpillar.

Design and Technology

After half term, we are going to be investigating sliders and levers. We will be using our new skills to create a lever or a slider to go in a book.

Music

As musicians, we will be exploring feeling through music and how music can make the world a better place. We will also be looking at composing music inspired by birdsong.

Computing

As users of technology, we will be developing our understanding of programming and using the Bee-Bots to learn how to programme.
