We're on a mission to improve children's oral health – and we'd like you to join us. 🗐

Sadly, almost a third of children develop tooth decay by the time they are five years old, making it the nation's most common childhood disease. In its report this year, The Royal College of Surgeons stated it was seriously concerned about the state of children's oral health in the country. At {my}dentist St Marychurch, we share that concern.

Due to previous demand, every other Saturday from 28<sup>th</sup> June until the end of August, we will be holding our "Kids Club" sessions for children to come and have a free one-off NHS checkup appointment with our lovely dentist Parsa Mosaddad.

To book an appointment for your child/children you just need to call 01803 328113 or pop into our St Marychurch practice and one of our reception team will be more than happy to help!

This won't register the child with the practice but should enable them to have an NHS dental check up and 1 course of treatment.

Please note, if any parents are unable to attend on a Saturday for various reasons, then we may have other availability if they contact the reception team.
